<u>Councilman Tighe</u> – Councilman Tighe discussed the process of selecting an engineer and indicated that he was very impressed with Mr. Polistina during the interview process. They wanted to select a person who would interact well with the residents of Linwood. Councilman Tighe also commended Councilman Gordon for his efforts in the process.
