LINWOOD COMMON COUNCIL MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING June 25, 2014

FLAG SALUTE:

Councilwoman Stacy DeDomenicis led the flag salute.

CALL TO ORDER

Council President Tighe called the meeting to order at 6:30 P.M., noting that the meeting had been advertised in compliance with the requirements of the Open Public Meetings Act.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES WITHOUT FORMAL READING

Councilman Beinfest motioned, seconded by Councilman Gordon, to approve the minutes of the June 11, 2014 Regular meeting without formal reading. All members of Council were in favor. Motion was approved.

RESOLUTIONS

A Resolution amending the 2014 Capital Budget

The Clerk read Resolution No. 116 of 2014 by title only. Councilman Paolone motioned, seconded by Councilwoman DeDomenicis to approve Resolution No. 116. A roll call vote was heard with seven in the affirmative. Motion was approved.

A Resolution extending the Agreement between the City of Northfield and the City of Linwood to share a Police Chief/Share Police Chief Services for a period of one year

The Clerk read Resolution No. 119 of 2014 by title only. Councilman Gordon motioned, seconded by Councilman Matik to approve Resolution No. 119. A roll call vote was heard with six in the affirmative and one abstention from Councilman Paolone. Motion was approved.

NEW BUSINESS

Council President Tighe advised that the Mayor has made an appointment to the position of Chief of Police of the Linwood Police Department which requires Council's consent. The Mayor announced that he was not involved in the interview process of the testing for the Chief's position. He thanked Councilmen Matik and Gordon for participating on the committee in his place. The Mayor's selection of the successful candidate was based on the test scores with a recommendation from the committee. The Mayor has appointed Colin Hickey as Chief of Police of the Linwood Police Department. Council President Tighe asked if there is a motion to approve a Resolution consenting to the Mayor's appointment. Councilman Matik motioned, seconded by Councilman Gordon, to confirm the Mayor's appointment of Colin Hickey to the position of Chief of Police of the Linwood Police Department. A roll call vote was heard with six in the affirmative and one abstention from Councilman Paolone. Motion was approved.

The Clerk read Ordinance No. 14 of 2014 by title only. Councilman Paolone motioned, seconded by Councilman Gordon to approve Ordinance No. 14 on first reading. A roll call vote was heard with seven in the affirmative. Motion was approved.
