# MEETING OPEN TO THE PUBLIC

Council President Tighe opened the floor to the public for discussion on any topic.

Tom Thanasoulis 220 W. Ocean Heights Ave, Linwood

Mr. Thanasoulis discussed the problems he is having from the bamboo planted by his neighbor. He is aware there are other homeowners experiencing similar problems. He asked City Council to adopt an Ordinance to address the issue. Mr. Thanasoulis presented pictures to Council of the bamboo.

#### Mike Portnov

Mr. Portnoy asked what is going on with Cheltenham Avenue. Council President Tighe advised that the City is not giving up any street ends. Mr. Portnoy indicated that his client approached City Council for a street vacation and was rejected. He now has a driveway on a portion of a paper street. Council President Tighe indicated that his client will most likely have to open up access because what he built is not within compliance with the Zoning Board approval. Mr. Youngblood included that the Zoning Board has no jurisdiction on the use of public rights of way. Mr. Portnoy asked why the certificate of occupancy (CO) is being held up. Council President Tighe asked him when he applied for the CO, as it could take up to three days. Mr. Portnoy indicated that he applied today. Council President Tighe indicated that the Council meeting is not the proper forum to discuss this. Council President Tighe is still waiting to discuss this matter with the City Solicitor and Zoning Board Solicitor. He asked Mr. Portnoy to meet him after tonight's meeting to continue the discussion.

Seeing and hearing no other members from the public wishing to be heard, Council President Tighe closed the floor.

### FINAL REMARKS BY MAYOR AND COUNCIL

<u>Councilman Beinfest</u> – Councilman Beinfest indicated that Linwood has some excellent police officers. He congratulated the members of the Police Department that were promoted and welcomed the new Patrolman.

<u>Councilman Gordon</u> – Councilman Gordon echoed the comments of Councilman Beinfest and extended his congratulations to the members of the Police Department. He also welcomed Dan Miller to the Recreation Board. <u>Councilman Paolone</u> – Councilman Paolone welcomed Dan Miller to the Recreation Board.

<u>Councilman Matik</u> – Councilman Matik agrees with Council's remarks. He will look into adopting an Ordinance for bamboo.

<u>Councilman Heun</u> – Councilman Heun indicated that there is a lot of engineering projects ongoing in the City. He expressed his sincere appreciation to Mr. Polistina for doing an excellent job.
