# LINWOOD COMMON COUNCIL MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING November 10, 2021

### **CALL TO ORDER**

Council President Ralph Paolone called the meeting to order at 6:16 P.M., noting that the meeting had been advertised in compliance with the requirements of the Open Public Meetings Act.

Councilman Ford motioned, seconded by Councilman Gordon, to approve the minutes of the October 27, 2021 Regular meeting without formal reading. All present members of Council were in favor. Motion was approved.

### MEETING OPEN TO THE PUBLIC

<u>Karen DiMeo, 605 Oakcrest Avenue, Linwood</u> – Ms. DiMeo discussed sink holes on her property and requested assistance from the City to correct the issues.

<u>Kathleen Spaeth, 108 Country Club Drive, Linwood</u> – Mrs. Spaeth reported that the attorney for the Linwood Country Club asked for a continuance in Court today. The request was granted. She also indicated that she can still hear noise from the Country Club, however it is not significantly audible.

Seeing and hearing no other members from the public wishing to be heard, Council President Paolone closed the floor.

### FINAL REMARKS BY MAYOR AND COUNCIL

<u>Councilman Gordon</u> – Councilman Gordon thanked everyone for coming to the meeting and speaking on issues. The City is aware of the issue at 605 Oakcrest and under the guidance of the City Engineer, work was completed in an effort to resolve the problem. They will investigate the current complaint.

<u>Councilman Ford</u> – Councilman Ford advised that he met with Ms. DiMeo yesterday and the Engineer will be out to look at the area. They will take photos and compare them to when the work was done. Public Works will televise the lines.

<u>Councilwoman Byrnes</u> – Councilwoman Byrnes thanked all the Veterans for their dedication to our Country. A banner thanking the Veterans has been installed along the fence on Shore Road at Memorial Park in observance of Veterans Day. She announced that the South Jersey Astronomy Club, along with the Environmental Commission, are hosting a star watch in the SJI park on Friday night.

<u>Council President Paolone</u> – Council President Paolone reminded everyone that it gets darker earlier now but sports teams are still practicing and playing games. He asked that everyone watch for kids crossing at the parks and to be safe. He congratulated the Mainland High School Girls Soccer team on winning the semifinals for the South Jersey competition and wished them luck in the finals.
