Discussions by the governing body or any public body of the City of Linwood concerning appointment, termination, terms and conditions of employment, performance evaluation, promotion or discipline of any current or prospective officer or employee may be held in closed session unless the individual requests in writing that the discussion be held in open session. Such request must be granted. Prior to the discussion by the governing body or any public body of the City of Linwood concerning such matters, the Clerk shall notify the affected person(s) of the meeting date, time and place, the matters to be discussed and the person's right to request that the discussion occur in open session. In the event more than one person is affected by the discussion and one of the affected persons does not request that the discussion be in open session, then the discussion shall be in closed session. If the individual(s) does not request that the discussion be held in open session, the governing body or other public body of the City of Linwood may at its sole discretion invite the affected individual(s) to attend the applicable portion of the closed session. Ultimately, the guidance as to notification of employees and the right to have the discussion in executive/closed session or in open session should be discussed with and be based upon the guidance and advice of the municipal solicitor and in conjunction with recent court decisions.

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

SECTION 3: Should any sentence, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 1: Chapter 277 Zoning, Section 277-11, I. Prohibited uses is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 227-11 Prohibited uses.

I. The first two sentences of this section shall be replaced with the following:

No motor vehicle, commercial vehicle or equipment, watercraft, (including but not limited to jet skis and waver runners), trailer, recreational vehicle or storage unit (trailer, PODS®, etc.) shall be parked in or on any grassy area that constitutes the front or side yard of any dwelling within the City of Linwood. All watercraft must be currently registered, in working order, covered and on a trailer only. All other vehicles must be registered and in working order. Parking of the above-mentioned classes of vehicles or storage units shall be confined to a paved, stone or gravel driveway or to the rear yard and shall not interfere with any required parking stall. For the parking or storage of any of the specified vehicles in a rear yard, the vehicles shall be no closer than ten (10) feet to any rear property line and no closer than ten (10) feet to any side property line.

- SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.
- SECTION 3: Should any sentence, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.



S3745 BROWN, ANDRZEJCZAK

1 AN ACT concerning excused absences for certain public school students and amending P.L.2015, c.297.

BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

- 1. Section 1 of P.L.2015, c.297 (C.18A:36-13.2) is amended to read as follows:
 - 1. a. Notwithstanding any law, rule, or regulation to the contrary, any pupil of a public school who is absent from school on:
 - (1) November 11, Veterans Day, attending a ceremony honoring a veteran or a member of the United States Armed Forces or the New Jersey National Guard returning from overseas deployments, or assisting a veteran at a hospital, food shelter, or any similar facility; or
 - (2) any school day participating in a musical performance at a military funeral honoring a veteran or a member of the United States Armed Forces or the New Jersey National Guard, including but not limited to, the playing of "Taps" in conjunction with a State or national veterans' organization,
- shall have the absence for those reasons recorded as an excused absence on the pupil's attendance record or on that of any group or class of which he is a member. Any transcript, application, employment form, or any similar form on which information concerning a pupil's attendance record is requested shall show, with respect to absences, only absences other than excused absences authorized pursuant to this subsection. In making a determination on whether or not a student has a perfect attendance record for the school year, a school district shall not consider as an absence an excused absence authorized pursuant to this subsection.
- b. A pupil shall provide such documentation as the superintendent or administrative principal of the school district deems necessary to prove the pupil meets the requirements for the excused absence under subsection a. of this section.
- c. As used in this section, "veteran" means a person who has served on active duty in the Armed Forces of the United States and who was discharged or released therefrom under conditions other than dishonorable.

S3745 BROWN, ANDRZEJCZAK

STATEMENT

This bill provides that any pupil of a public school who is absent from school on any day to participate in a musical performance at a military funeral honoring a veteran or a member of the United States Armed Forces or the New Jersey National Guard, including but not limited to, the playing of "Taps" in conjunction with a national veterans' organization, will have the absence recorded as an excused absence. Under the bill, the absence will be recorded as an excused absence on the pupil's attendance record or on that of any group or class of which he is a member. Any transcript, application, employment form, or any similar form on which information concerning a pupil's attendance record is requested will show only absences other than excused absences authorized under the bill.

- WHEREAS, in consideration of receipt of Green Acres funding, the Common Council of the City of Linwood is desirous of complying with the request of New Jersey DEP;
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Common Council of the City of Linwood, that the deed transferring ownership to the City of Linwood of Block 6, Lot 29 be revised, removing the twenty-five foot wide access easement as requested by New Jersey DEP in consideration of the Green Acres funding;
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor and City Clerk be and are hereby duly authorized, empowered and directed to execute a revised Deed from the City of Linwood to the City of Linwood for Block 6, Lot 29 in the City of Linwood along with any and all other necessary documents in order to effect transfer of this property.

On June 7th, 2019 at 11:00 A.M., the City of Linwood received informal bids for the cleaning of four (4) existing seepage pits and installation of a trash rack or similar grating system in the tank closest to the property at 605 E. Oakcrest Avenue in the City of Linwood. The bid package was sent to a total of three (3) contractors and all three (3) contractors submitted pricing for the project. The amounts are shown below:
