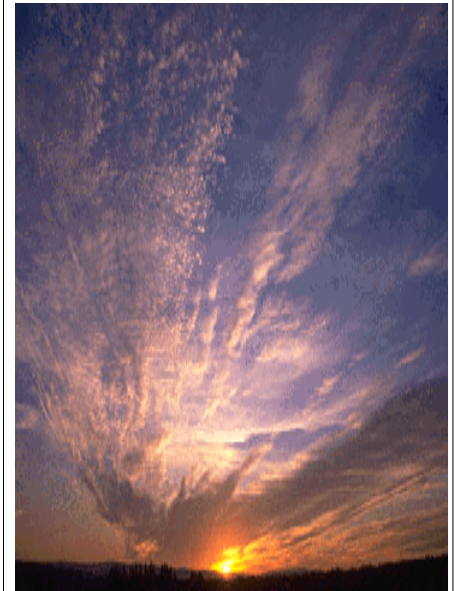

PREPARATIONS IN THE EVENT OF SEVERE WEATHER CONDITIONS



In the event of projected severe weather conditions such as Hurricanes, Tropical storms, or severe Winter ice or snow storms use good common sense and make sure you and your family are prepared.

Inform your children of what to expect from the storm and get them involved in the preparations. Toys, lawn and patio furniture, trash cans, and loose

light weight building materials should be stored away in sheds, garages and basements or secured in such a way that high winds could not move them.

Don't forget about your pets. Animals also need to be brought in-doors during severe weather conditions.

Be prepared for possible extended power outages before, during and after severe storms. In the event of a power outage, turn off all appliances, air conditioners, heaters, and water heaters. Appliances at imminent risk of being affected by flooding should have the gas and electric supply to the equipment shut off.

Emergency Preparedness Kits

Your kit should include:

- * One or more flashlights
- * A battery-powered radio with fresh batteries
- * Spare batteries for radio and flashlights
- * Non-perishable foods
- * A manual can opener
- * A supply of fresh water (enough for several days)
- * A first-aid kit
- * Essential medications for those who use prescriptions
- * Pillows and blankets or sleeping bags
- * Diapers, wipes and baby food if necessary (enough for several days)
