- 2. \$5 per permit for Veterans
- 3. \$25 for all other residents

B. Non-Residents

- 1. \$50 per permit
- 2. Senior citizens 65 years or older and Veterans, the fee will be \$5 per permit January 1 through March 31 and \$50 per permit April 1 through December 31

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.
